What Are Clumps?

Learn skills required to become a performer with Clumps. This activity develops listening and concentration skills, and gives you the opportunity to work with a number of different people in groups.

What do you need?

- A pen or pencil
- Dram Journal Template

Why are we doing this?

Clumps is an extension of Focused Walking. It is a fast-paced activity that requires you to think quickly and stay alert. This activity helps build up the foundations required for becoming a performer including:

- staying alert
- quick thinking
- being focused
- becoming energized
- learning to work as a team
