



Making a Portrait

Create a portrait of a family member or friend.

Make

1. Get your family member or friend to take on a pose that represents them. Remind them they have to hold this pose for some time!
2. Begin the outline of your portrait, start in pencil so that you can make any changes as you go.
3. Add the important details to your portrait. These are the person's special features like hair style and colour, eye colour, their expression and the things that show who they are.
4. Compose the background of your portrait.
