## Introduce the concept

Brainstorm activities, learning or special moments from the session/day. This could be an individual activity or a class list. It may take too long to include all students ideas in the song so pick a few or rotate through the whole class over several sessions.

## Introduce the song

Encourage students to come up with actions that will help them remember the song. Once the students know the song, play with changing the dynamics (the volume). How loudly or softly can they sing the song or specific words?

## Music tip

This song uses the same melody and the easiest chords for the 'Hey Diddle Diddle' song. The audio recording is in a different key.

## Adapt

Add in new actions each sessions. Actions can be brainstormed as group. If someone's favourite part of the day was the silly game, students can come up with an action to demonstrate the silly game.
